The Pyramids and the Nile in Style

Full Day: Up to 8-9 hours



Combining Cairo's kaleidoscopic culture, history and sights, this full day tour leaves no stone unturned. After driving through Egypt's cultivated deserts from Alexandria, you'll arrive in the metropolis of Cairo, where the last remaining Wonder of the Ancient World, the Pyramid of Giza, is first on the itinerary. The Western Plateau affords a spine-tingling panoramic view, then,

from the base of Chephren's pyramid, enjoy free time to unravel the mysteries of ancient Egypt yourself. Drive through the valley to catch sight of the imposing Sphinx, before stepping aboard a luxurious cruise to take you gliding along the Nile into the center of Cairo. Sit back and tuck into a lavish buffet lunch and watch belly dancers and a folkloric show as the city's landmarks appear around you. Back on dry land, you'll head to the Citadel of Saladin and the mesmerizing Alabaster Mosque of Muhammed Ali to admire its exquisite interior as well as Cairo's skyline from the top of the hill. After visiting a Papyrus Institute, there's time for souvenir shopping before the journey back to the port.

Classic Cairo

Full Day: Up to 8-9 hours



The largest city in Africa and all its top sights are waiting to be discovered on this full day excursion from Alexandria. Leaving the port in a luxury air-conditioned coach, you'll journey south towards Cairo. And your first port of call will be the last remaining Wonder of the Ancient World, the mighty Pyramid of Giza. From the base of

Chephren's pyramid, the time is yours to explore these ancient marvels under your own steam. If you wish, climb aboard a camel, or simply roam the complex on foot. Then, continuing through the valley, you'll spot the supreme Sphinx guarding the land. A buffet lunch will be served at a 5-star hotel, after which, there's more sightseeing on the agenda – this time in the heart of Cairo. From the bustling Tahrir (Liberty) Square, you'll head to the National Archaeological Museum to become acquainted with Egypt's ancient history - spanning an incredible 50 centuries - through eye-catching antiquities, including the collection of King Tutankhamen. After visiting a Papyrus Institute, there's some time dedicated to souvenir shopping before travelling back to the cruise ship.
