You will arrive in St. Georges, a World Heritage Site, where you can enjoy 45 minutes on your own to explore or shop in this unique old town, with its narrow winding alleys, cobblestone streets, picturesque cottages and museums. Your drive continues along the North Shore Road, through Flatts Village, and on to the City of Hamilton, the capital of Bermuda, before returning to Kings Wharf pier.
