One of the late Sheikh Zayed bin Al Nahyan's visionary achievements was to turn Sir Bani Yas island into a wildlife sanctuary, where hunting is banned, that offers both endangered and other species of local and foreign origin a home to roam free. Part of this "Greening of the Desert" program was also aimed at making the desert environment more hospitable for human habitation. This appealing look at the island intends to showcase the legacy left by Sheikh Zayed, which includes a development policy whose top priority is to promote harmony between nature and culture. The island provides a safe habitat for numerous freeroaming animals as well as myriad trees and other vegetation. Your sightseeing ride around Sir Bani Yas will include a stop at the historical Falconry site, overlooking the northern coast, providing interesting facts on the places visited.

Please note: Guests will receive audio guides in several language. This tour is not available to guests with mobility problems, using a wheelchair and for pregnant women. Guests are recommended to wear sport shoes high-factor sunscreen. Minimum age to take part in this tour is 4. Sighting of animals cannot be guaranteed all the time; the tour follows a circular itinerary around the island without approaching the reserve too much for safety reasons.
