#### **FLORIDA**

#### **Trolley and Ernest Hemingway House**



Difficulty Level: Moderate

**Duration:** 2 hours

You will be escorted from the ship to the waiting Conch Tour Trains and/or Old Town Trolleys, a walk of about 250 yards over flat, even terrain. Your guide will entertain and delight you with over 100 points of interest and colorful stories about the

island's history and its charming characters. After your tour around the island, you will disembark at the Ernest Hemingway Home and Museum. From 1931 to 1961, Hemingway owned this Spanish Colonial style home, where he wrote some of his most famous works like "To Have and Have Not". Fishing, writing, and enjoying his friends, "Papa" Hemingway was one of the most famous residents whose presence and influence on the island continue to this day.

**Please Note:** Wheelchair bound guests who wish to participate should inform the Excursion Office prior. Hemingway Home is wheelchair accessible on the first floor only. A video of the second level can be viewed on the main floor.

## **Discover Key West**



**Difficulty Level:** Moderate **Duration:** 2 ½ hours

Please sit back, relax and discover Key West from the comfort of a World-Famous Conch Tour Train and/or Old Town Trolley. Your personal guide will delight and entertain you for the one-hour tour. You will hear stories and anecdotes about the pirates

and ship wreckers, the Navy, and all the colorful characters that make up Key West's colorful history! Follow your tour by immersing yourself in the glories of the undersea world at the Key West Aquarium, with hundreds of different species of local marine life and a touch tank. Then go back over 100 years with a live show by local actors at the Shipwreck Treasure Museum and learn what made Key West the richest city in the United States.

Please Note: Wheelchair bound guests who wish to participate should inform the Excursion Office prior. Shipwreck Treasure Museum is wheelchair accessible on the first floor only. A video of the second level can be viewed on the main floor. Guests are at their leisure to visit the Aquarium and/or the Shipwreck Museum, (both unguided and showing the stubs of the excursion ticket). The museum offers a - short live show - which runs every 20 minutes. Guests will walk back to the ship at their leisure.

#### **Glass Bottom Boat**



**Difficulty Level:** Easy **Duration:** 2 ½ hours

Explore dramatic underwater vistas generally reserved for scuba divers. A wide variety of fish and other sea creatures awaits you as you gaze into the underwater world of Key West. Fury's Glass Bottom Boat, The Pride of Key West, offers passengers a

smooth ride on our modern Catamaran, seated sun deck and air-conditioned, enclosed viewing area as well as restrooms and a snack bar.

#### **Key West Sights & Key Lime Bites**



**Difficulty Level:** Easy **Duration:** 2 hours

Meet your local guide at the pier for a stroll along palm-lined streets. Enjoy the fresh air and sunshine as your guide shares fascinating tidbits about the city's culture and history not found in your guide book. Walk past Kenny Chesney's vacation home

then head over to see Jimmy Buffet's recording studio. Along the way, we will stop at two iconic hotspots. You will get the opportunity to taste what's hot at Peppers of Key West, then cool down at Kermit's Key Lime Shoppe with a slice of his classic pie or his signature frozen key lime pie dipped in Belgian chocolate. Enjoy a stop at the historic seaport before making your way back to Mallory Square and then to the cruise ship pier.

**Please note:** This tour is entirely walking, no transportation involved. Therefore, it is recommended that guests wear comfortable shoes. Participants must be able to walk approximately 0.5 miles.
